		at south gate near Memorial Way	grows up to 4 m high, with blue, lilac and white, pea-shaped flowers which bloom from October to December. The "P" in <i>Psoralea</i> is silent and the name is pronounced as if it began with the "s". The common names fountain bush or 'fonteinbos' refer to the fact that it grows along streams and in wet places. There are 130 species worldwide with 50 species occurring in southern Africa.
